PROM

Fivay High School will be hosting our first Prom on Friday, April 29, 2011. The day was originally scheduled as a student holiday but is now a regular school day for students. Students are expected to be in attendance for the day. If it is necessary for a student to check out of school, they will need to follow the standard procedure for leaving school early. (see below) More information will be given out after Spring Break concerning Prom tickets, dress code etc...

Attendance Reminders:

Students who need to leave school early should bring a note to the main office before school starts on the day that they are checking out. The note must contain their full name, their student number, parent/guardian's signature and a phone number where a parent/guardian may be reached. An early dismissal slip will be generated for the student in the main office, which will decrease the parent wait time when picking up students. Parents, please have a photo ID and be patient as we check records to insure your child's safety.

Students who have been absent need to bring a note from their parent/guardian or from their doctor within two days of their return to school. These notes should contain the full name of the student as well as the date of the absence and the student number. The notes should be placed in the basket on the counter in the Guidance Office.
