

REGISTRATION & COURSE REQUESTS
2012-2013

Registration for classes for the 2012-13 school year are now complete for grades 8 through 11 at Fivay High School. We are happy to welcome new group of 9th graders from Bayonet Point Middle School, Hudson Middle School, and Crews Lake Middle School.

As part of the registration process, students meet with their guidance counselors to:

- Review their graduation requirements
- Complete their course cards
- Gain an understanding of their academic history and current academic standing
- Learn about opportunities for acceleration and advanced placements (Honors, Advanced Placement, and Dual Enrollment)
- Choose their core academic and elective courses
- Complete their ePep (electronic personalized education plan) on facts.org

All students completed a course card and the online registration process. The online registration process allows students to enter their course requests directly into the computer system. Student schedules will be based on this input.

Registration appointments will be available in early summer for those incoming students still needing to register for the 2012-2013 school year. Please stay tune to the website for these dates and more information. We will post this information as soon as it becomes available.

Attention Current Juniors:

The 2011 State of Florida Legislature amended section (s.) 1008.30, Florida Statute (F.S.) to require the evaluation of college readiness for selected students prior to the 12th grade. This amendment also requires the remediation in specific classes as a high school graduation requirement. For students who do not meet the listed cut score requirements, statute requires postsecondary preparatory instruction to be completed for high school graduation. The Florida Department of Education has designated English 4: Florida College Prep (# 1001405) and Math for College Readiness (#1200700) as meeting the postsecondary preparatory requirements.

Students who do not achieve these cut scores will be required to take the appropriate course listed above in their senior year. The Math for College Readiness will count as a high school mathematics graduation requirement and the English 4: Florida College Prep will count as the senior English Language Arts requirement.
