## Assessment Graduation Requirements

According to Florida law, students must meet certain academic requirements to earn a high school diploma from a public school including passing required courses and passing statewide assessments. Passing scores for the statewide assessments are determined by the State Board of Education (SBE). The table provides the SBE scores for a concordant or comparative score.
